KFOR SOLDIERS DETAIN SIX MEN

CAMP BONDSTEEL, Kosovo – KFOR soldiers detained six Kosovo men on Feb. 11 in Urosevac/Ferizaj under the authority of United Nations Security Council Resolution 1244 for suspected involvement in activities that threaten the safe and secure environment in Kosovo.

The six men were transported to Camp Bondsteel and detained overnight in the Bondsteel Detention Facility. Five detainees were released on Feb. 12 after it was determined they were no longer a threat to the safe and secure environment.

One man, still considered a threat to the safe and secure environment, remains in the BDF.

“KFOR is committed to a safe and secure environment and will not tolerate activities that threaten it,” said Captain Mike Bush, Multi-National Brigade (East) spokesman. “We will continue to ensure that any threat to the safety and well being of the good people of Kosovo is dealt with swiftly and efficiently under the authority of UNSCR 1244.”
