KFOR TRANSFERS TWO DETAINEES TO CIVPOL

CAMP BONDSTEEL, Kosovo – Two men detained by KFOR on March 7, under the authority of United Nations Security Council Resolution 1244, have been transferred to UNMIK CIVPOL custody.

Fatmir Lakna was detained for suspected weapons violation in the town of Krajn Del.

Aslan Bajrami was stopped at a Vehicle Check Point in Dobrcane and detained under suspicion of possible involvement with the Administrative Boundary Line (ABL) incident on 7 March.

"KFOR is committed to a safe and secure environment and we will continue to ensure that any threat to the safety and well being of the good people of Kosovo is dealt with swiftly and efficiently under the authority of UNSCR 1244," said Captain Mike Bush.
