2 Suspects Detained

Ferizaj/Urosevac, KOSOVO – Avdil Jakupi and Adnan Abazi turned themselves in to Multi-national Brigade (East) soldiers at 12:37 p.m. Friday.

Jakupi and Abazi were transported to Camp Bondsteel for questioning while details of their transfer to United Nations Mission in Kosovo Police were finalized. The two men were turned over to UNMIK-Police at 9:41 p.m. Friday night.

Jakupi was wanted for felonious acts and ties to terrorism in the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia. Abazi possessed an AKSh identification card and was detained for membership in an illegal organization.
