**Suspicious Mounds Investigated**

**Camp Bondsteel, KOSOVO** – Multi-national Brigade (East) military police initiated an investigation and contacted the United Nations Mission in Kosovo Office of Missing Persons and Forensics after a local employee reported finding suspicious mounds of dirt while working, Feb. 3.

After the MNB(E) Explosives Ordnance Disposal team ensured the area was clear of unexploded ordnance, the UNMIK team began a three-day investigation that culminated in an excavation of the site, Feb. 6. Investigators found no evidence of human remains and reached the final determination that the mounds are not graves.
