MNB(E) DETERMINES FYROM BORDER IS SECURE

CAMP BONDSTEEL, Kosovo – U.S. KFOR has determined that the FYROM border remains stable, after looking into claims of increased activities threatening the border.

Reports in the media indicated that activity along the border threatened the safety situation in Kosovo. MNB(E) observed the situation and determined the border remained secure.

“After close observation along the FYROM border, we have no indications of increased activities that pose a threat to Kosovo security,” stated Brigadier General Jerry G. Beck Jr., Commander MNB(E). “We will continue patrolling the border, as we have done in the past and we will continue to provide a safe and secure environment for the people of Kosovo.”

KFOR has provided a commitment to Kosovo security since 1999.
