MNB(E) Detains Nine People

Camp Bondsteel, Kosovo: Since violence erupted across Kosovo March 17, Multi-national Brigade (East) soldiers have detained nine people at Camp Bondsteel for questioning related to the riots. Four of those people were released after questioning, three remain at Camp Bondsteel and two were turned over to the Kosovo Police Service.

“It is our intent to treat all detained persons with dignity and respect”, said Maj. Christopher J. Cole, MNB(E) public affairs officer. “Our personnel work quickly to determine if any of them were involved in illegal activity and to turn over to the KPS those who were.”

MNB(E) continues to support the Kosovo Police Service and United Nations Mission in Kosovo Police in an effort to identify and apprehend those responsible for the violence.
